

Cadet Induction Weekend Joining Information & Kit List

You have been selected to attend the above course which will be held at Chickerell Camp in Dorset. The course is intended to give you an introduction to Corps life, what is available to you during your Corps career and to provide you with training and examinations that will enable you to undertake Flying, Gliding and First Aid. You will also gain experience in Drill and all aspects of wearing and maintaining your uniform. Please hand over your completed TG21 (&TG23 if necessary) on arrival, along with the £5 course fee, and you will be briefed on your accommodation, and course timetable.

The following information is designed to enable you to arrive fully prepared and obtain the maximum benefit from the course:

1. **Kit List** – Attached is the course Kit List. Please make sure you bring **all** uniform listed and check it is clean, tidy and fits comfortably. Females are to bring extra pairs of tights and males are to wear black socks.
2. You must remember to bring your **3822 Record of Service Book** and suitable writing materials.
3. **Inspections** – Your first inspection will be on Saturday morning, so ensure you bring the correct uniform and that it is in good order.
4. **Performance** – We expect 100% performance and good behaviour from you throughout the course. We will be continuously observing and marking you on your attitude and effort while on the course.
5. You will be taught Map Reading, and Initial Expedition Training, but assessment will be left until you get back your unit.
6. **General** – you will be given a copy of the course programme on arrival, but **awareness of the following** should help:
 - Correct etiquette towards Officers and Staff.
 - Basic drill.
 - Punctuality for all training sessions.

Please remember to tell a member of staff at the beginning of the course if you have any special requirements that will aid your learning on the course. We look forward to meeting you and hope you have an enjoyable and informative weekend.

The course is scheduled to **assemble for 20:00 on Friday evening**, and will begin as soon as the necessary safety briefings have been given.
