

## **SNCO Course Joining Information & Kit List**

You have been selected to attend the above course, please arrange to arrive at Chickerell on Friday evening no later than 20:00 as the course commences at 20:30 promptly. Hand in your completed TG21 (&TG23 if required) and your £5 course fee. You will be allocated accommodation, and your timetable.

The following information is designed to enable you to arrive fully prepared and ready to derive the maximum benefit from the course.

1. **Kit List** – as per joining instructions plus a set of coveralls and trainers for Practical Leadership Tasks (PLTs). If unable to obtain coveralls you may bring combat clothing, but this does take longer to change in and out of.
2. **Arrival** – you should make every effort to arrive punctually. This sets a good example and ensures you do not miss any briefings.
3. **Inspections** – your first inspection will be first thing on Saturday morning, so ensure you have the correct items of uniform and they are in good order.
4. **Performance** – you will be continuously observed throughout the course so we expect 100 per cent effort and good behaviour. Remember, the younger cadets will look up to you as senior cadets in the Wing; do not let us down.
5. **Course subjects** – you will receive a copy of the course programme on arrival, but an awareness of the following will help your preparation. (not in any order)
  - Introductions – you and us.
  - Role of SNCO
  - Lecture techniques
  - Drill ( not learning drill, but taking the squad and ceremonial parades)
  - Leadership theory
  - Command tasks (PLTs)
  - Presentations (subjects include: first aid, map reading, D of E award, Initial Expedition Training, R.A.F.)
